COOKIE POLICY

Pursuant to Art. 13 Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on personal data processing

WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files that websites visited by users send to their terminals, where they are stored and then transmitted back to the same websites upon the next visit.

In general, they can be installed:

- directly by the owner and/or manager of the website (so-called first-party cookies);
- by entities unrelated to the website visited by the user (so-called third-party cookies); information regarding their privacy and use can be found directly on the respective providers' websites.

ARE THERE DIFFERENT TYPES OF COOKIES?

Yes, there are technical cookies (used to facilitate browsing), analytical cookies (used for statistical purposes), performance cookies, and profiling cookies (aimed at monitoring the user's behavior while browsing).

WHAT COOKIES DOES THE WEBSITE USE?

Chrome

1. Start Chrome on your device.
2. At the top right, click the three-dot icon and then go to "Settings."
3. In the window, at the bottom, click on "Advanced."
4. Under "Privacy and Security," click on "Content Settings."
5. Click "Cookies".
6. You can disable all or only some cookies in this section.

Mozilla Firefox

1. Start Firefox on your device.
2. Click the "Menu" button (represented by an icon with three parallel lines, located at the top right), and then select "Options."

3. Select the “Privacy & Security” panel and then go to the “Cookies and Site Data” section.
4. In this section, you can decide which cookies to accept and how long to keep them on your device.

Internet Explorer 10

1. Start Internet Explorer on your device.
2. Select the Tools button and then select Internet Options.

I DIRITTI DELL'INTERESSATO.

The user will always have the right to obtain from the Controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data concerning them are being processed and, if so, to gain access to the personal data and to the information referred to in Art. 15 GDPR. In addition, the user has the right to obtain the rectification, erasure, and restriction of the processing of their personal data held by the Controller. Finally, the user has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the Member State in which they reside/work (for Italy, the Italian Data Protection Authority) or of the place where the alleged violation occurred.
